

## 2019 Neuropathology Brain Tumor Banking at CHP

During intraoperative consult, the **NEUROPATHOLOGIST** must:

- 1) **CONFIRM** the presence of brain tumor tissue
- 2) render an **INTRAOPERATIVE DIAGNOSIS**
- 3) **ENSURE** that adequate fresh tissue is submitted for **DIAGNOSIS**
- 4) **FREEZE** any excess fresh tissue submitted to pathology for **CBTTC**  
(Children's Brain Tumor Tissue Consortium) - 3 tubes of ~50-100 mg
- 5) **RELEASE** any additional fresh tumor tissue as **EXCESS** so that it can be used  
by **NEUROSURGERY TISSUE BANK** for tissue culture IRB # PRO17100390.

**1/2/2019 – As of this date there are no other approved protocols for brain tumor tissue banking**

The CBTTC frozen samples are logged in by Carol Wilkes who stores them.

Once a month, Kim contacts Carol Wilkes who retrieves the tissue for Kim, who will ship to CBTTC.
